INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION

Students are admitted into the coursework only option. On completion of 12 credit hours, students will continue in the coursework only option or transfer into the research paper or thesis option in accordance with program rules and submit this form to the Office of Graduate Programs to confirm the pathway to graduation. Course selection must meet [calendar requirements](#) in order to be eligible for graduation.

Elective Selection

All students are required to take 6 credits of electives from the list in the [calendar](#). Electives may also be chosen from Global Development and Global Environment courses not already selected as credits being used to meet the course requirement in these areas.

Course-based and research paper students will also complete coursework.

Course-based students are required to complete an additional course each in the Global Development and Global Environment study areas and another 3 credits of electives. Students in the course-based degree must ensure they have courses from at least three different subject areas reflected in their course choices.

Research paper students complete an additional course drawn from the Global Development or Global Environment study areas and a further 3 credits of electives.

Thesis students meet their coursework requirement by completing the required courses identified in the first section of this form and do not take further electives.

Once the final approved coursework has been identified, this form should be submitted to the Office of Graduate Programs for processing. Deadlines can be found on the Office of Graduate Programs website.
