Expertise include educational planning; strategic and financial planning; budgeting and finance; project financing; financial analysis and reporting; human resource management and organization development; management information and IT systems; procurement and general administration; capital projects and facilities management; corporate affairs; internal audit; and program management.

#### KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

## **Strategic Planning**

- Led integrated planning and budget for the University of Northern British Columbia (annual turnover >\$100 million).
- Led the development of an Integrated Implementation Plan for the University of Central Asia (UCA) including phasing approach; academic, financial and human resource projections; and financing model for operations and capital costs (\$1.4 billion over 25 years).
- Developed three to five-year rolling plans and budgets for the University of Central Asia: annually since 2008 (average annual turnover for operations at Phase I cruising level \$25 million).
- Prepared three-year rolling plans and budgets for the Aga Khan Education Service (AKES), Pakistan through increased participation from the grassroots level (average annual turnover ~\$10 million): overall cost recovery increased from 55% to 70% over a five-year period.
- Developed a 15-year long-term strategic plan for AKES, Pakistan to increase access to quality education from 30% to 60% for catchment population. This included organizational vision, core ideology, gap analysis, goal setting, strategies and operational plan: access study 2007-2008 and portfolio review were the basis for the proposed long-term strategy.
- Led the education access study in 2007-2008 (survey of 100,000 households across Pakistan), which included envisioning long-term desired aspirations, analysis of key challenges and strangle points, historical analysis, analysis of market trends, overall social development (education) scene in the region, critical review of alternate strategies and recommendations for long-term strategy.
- Developed and implemented the long-term educational development plan for Afghan refugees (over 20,000 children and adults) providing structured solutions to turn their tragedy into opportunity.

#### **Program Planning and Implementation**

- Re-aligned the academic structure of seven Aga Khan Schools in Karachi and Southern Pakistan (over 10,000 students) including development and implementation of the plan for single-shift operations and expansion of the network of Higher Secondary Schools.
- Led a comprehensive portfolio review of all 174 Aga Khan Schools in Northern Pakistan (over 27,500 students) along with recommendations for future development and rationalization.
- Successful final evaluation of European Commission (EC) funded Northern Pakistan Education Program (NPEP) phase I (1997-2003) €14.4 million; secured additional award of €20 million educational development grant from the EC for the period 2003-2008 for educational initiatives in the Northern Areas and Chitral (NPEP phase II); formulated and implemented the exit strategy for EC funded NPEP phase II (2003-2008) including human resource and staffing strategy and alternative options to ensure continuation of educational programs within limited resources.
- Formulated the operational plan for the introduction of pre-primary classes in Chitral and English as medium of instruction at 51 Aga Khan Schools in Chitral (over 6,000 students).
- Conceptualized and implemented a school preparation and placement program for facilitating child refugees to access and excel in formal schooling by bringing the enormously varying academic abilities of similar age groups to uniformity (100% success in integration and academic outcomes).

## **Financial Management**

- Spearheaded the budgeting, cash flow planning, financial monitoring and reporting for UCA's capital projects (Phase I of three campuses: \$285 million) and ongoing operations (Phase I cruising level: \$25 million/annually).
- Led the successful negotiation for the \$30m financing facility from the United States' Overseers Private Investment Corporation for the University of Central Asia's Khorog (Tajikistan) campus.
- Led the implementation of the financial information system (iSCALA); internal control and processes; Financial Policies and Procedures Manual; regular financial reporting and dashboards, IFRS compliant financial statements and annual external audits with clean audit reports.
- Established and implemented a comprehensive financial assistance program for the University of Central Asia comprising merit scholarships, need-based grants and student loans. This included policies and procedures; process flow, forms and guidelines; assessment criteria matrix; organization structure; and building the capacity of local human resources (Phase I cruising level: \$3 million/annually).
- Established grant management mechanism including budgeting, accounting and reporting systems: more than 100 grants over \$30 million secured up to 2019 including from Global Affairs Canada, International Development Research Centre, United States Agency for International Development, Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs-Norway, the World Bank, and Swiss Agency for Development.

#### **Capital Projects**

- Implementation of works packages-based in-house construction management strategy for completing the Phase I of University campuses in Naryn, Kyrgyz Republic (\$85m) and Khorog, Tajikistan (\$94m) within time and budget despite significant geographic challenges while ensuring optimal socio-economic benefit to the local communities (more than \$475m over 25 years).
- Feasibility study for six Aga Khan Higher Secondary Schools and two Aga Khan High Schools across Pakistan; feasibility study and expansion plan for the Aga Khan Higher Secondary School, Karachi, enabling 100% increase in capacity within the same infrastructure.

#### **Administrative Services**

- Spearheaded the integration of administrative services across all units of the University, streamlining of procurement processes and formalization of UCA Procurement Policy and procurement arrangements through effective negotiations and finalization of framework contracts.
- Reviewed and implemented adequate insurance provision for University properties and assets as well as life, personal accident and medical insurance for faculty and staff.

## **Human Resource Management and Organizational Development**

- Formulated and implemented a multi-pronged strategy for building capacity of local human resources and developing institutional systems and processes at the University of Central Asia.
- Recommended proposed transition and long-term organizational structure for effective and efficient management of AKES, Pakistan while maintaining focus on school improvement.
- Developed and implemented field-based planning framework for program development, implementation, monitoring and tracking of key performance indicators.
- Established and implemented an effective and attractive compensation and benefit structure for faculty of the Aga Khan Higher Secondary School, Karachi to attract and retain quality staff, including accelerated salary increment plan, leave encashment, attendance bonus, performance incentives, medical benefits, car loans, etc.
- Developed capacity of Afghan refugees for program implementation and future leadership roles and responsibilities.
