



## **Student Employment Opportunities**

As a **Peer-Assisted Study Session (PASS) leader**, you will support student learning and skill development by conducting PASS sessions with students from a particular course (usually a first- or second-year science course). You will be trained in student leadership, group facilitation methods, and learning strategies through initial and ongoing training, offered by certified supplemental instruction/PASS supervisors. The ASC offers PASS supports for courses in **mathematics, physics, statistics, chemistry, and computer science**.

Examples of typical PASS offerings include (but are not limited to) the following:

MATH 100, 101, 115, 150, 152, 200, 220, 230;  
CHEM 100, 101, 201, 203;  
CPSC 141;  
STAT 371;

Additional courses may be participating in the PASS program in certain semesters, subject to student needs and funding from departments.

Applicants must meet the following requirements and qualifications:

- You have taken and done well in the course (a grade of A or higher)
- You are available 8 hours per week to attend lectures, prepare and facilitate sessions, and participate in training
- You like working with other students and are sensitive to others' learning needs

Scheduling is flexible, dependent on your availability.
