

## **UNBC Engineering Student Code of Ethics**

As a UNBC Engineering student, I shall:

- 1. Hold paramount safety, health and sustainability
- 2. Practice a culture of safety
- 3. Communicate openly
- 4. Show everyone respect
- 5. Treat everyone equitably
- 6. Act with honesty and integrity
- 7. Contribute to teamwork equitably
- 8. Teach others
- 9. Take ownership of my learning

## Examples

- 1. Hold paramount safety, health and sustainability
  - a. Develop solutions that protect society and the environment for current and future generations
- 2. Practice a culture of safety
  - a. Follow safety rules as appropriate to lab work, fieldwork and internet activities
  - b. "If you see something, say something"
    - i. If you notice unsafe practices, report them to the people in charge
  - c. Only participate in lab and fieldwork if you have sufficient skills and knowledge to ensure safety
  - d. Contribute to a welcoming learning environment in which people feel comfortable
  - e. Minimize risk in activities and in coursework
- 3. Communicate openly
  - a. Clearly document all your work
  - b. Remember that people's safety can be directly tied to our ability to communicate
  - c. Communicate openly and often with your teammates to avoid misunderstandings
  - d. Be open-minded
    - i. Being open-minded makes room for opinions and ideas that you may not have considered
- 4. Show everyone respect
  - a. Respect differences
  - b. Treat mistakes as learning opportunities
  - c. Be respectful of everyone's ideas
  - d. Create a safe zone for other students to express their ideas without being judged
  - e. Apply decency and compassion throughout any and all communication
  - f. Treat instructors, teaching assistants, student markers and staff with respect
- 5. Treat everyone equitably
  - a. Everyone should be given fair opportunity to voice their opinions and ideas
  - b. Every voice should have a chance to be heard and should be considered
  - c. Everyone deserves fair opportunity to be recognized in their work
  - d. Every team member should be willing to put past conflicts behind them



- 6. Act with honesty and integrity
  - a. Don't plagiarize
  - b. Complete work to the best of your abilities
  - c. Complete work on time
  - d. Accept personal responsibility
  - e. Defend others
    - i. report unfair treatment
    - ii. stand up for one another, both in and outside class.
  - f. Keep confidential information confidential
- 7. Contribute to teamwork equitably
  - a. Do your fair share of the work
    - i. Be accountable to your teammates
    - ii. Share your ideas
    - iii. Communicate clearly if something comes up that prevents you from following through on your commitments
  - b. Approach teamwork with a good attitude
    - i. Contribute to a team environment that encourages open communication
    - ii. Aim to reach fair agreements with your teammates
  - c. Distribute work equitably
    - i. Divide work based on team member strengths and their learning objectives
    - ii. Help teammates learn new skills
  - d. Don't rob others of the opportunity to contribute to team projects
- 8. Teach others
  - a. Help people
    - i. Do your best to help your fellow classmates if they are struggling or need any type of help
    - ii. Work collaboratively with your fellow classmates
    - iii. Encourage classmates to feel welcome in asking for help
    - iv. Do not let anyone copy your work
  - b. Provide constructive feedback
    - i. Give constructive and respectful feedback to classmates
    - ii. Balance negative feedback with positive feedback
    - iii. Before giving feedback, ask your peers if they're open to feedback
  - c. Do not distract others in learning environments
- 9. Take ownership of my learning
  - a. Actively participate in developing personal skills and knowledge
  - b. Develop a mindset of life-long learning
