



Student Nomination Form to Serve on UNBC Senate

In accordance with the Senate Election Rules and the *University Act* of British Columbia, in order to nominate, be nominated, vote, or serve on Senate as a Student member, the following criteria must be met:

- Be a student who is a member of either the Northern Undergraduate Student Society or the Northern British Columbia Graduate Students' Society, and
- Be a student in good standing (not on academic probation), and
- Be an undergraduate student registered in at least one course in the semester in which a vacancy arises and have been registered in the semester immediately preceding the one in which the vacancy arises. Registration in the May semester is not a requirement to meet this condition provided that, if the vacancy arises during the May or September semesters, the student is registered for the September semester and was registered during the preceding January semester, or
- Be registered in a co-op work term in the semester in which a vacancy arises, or
- Be a graduate student who is currently enrolled in a program leading to a graduate degree.

Elected positions are designated for graduate and undergraduate students on the UNBC Senate. Any student meeting the eligibility requirements noted above may seek nomination to serve in these positions.
