THE TOWN

Tumbler Ridge is a dream destination for outdoor enthusiasts, from high-energy to laid back. Tumbler Ridge is a district municipality in the foothills of the B.C. Rockies in northeastern British Columbia, Canada, and a member municipality of the Peace River Regional District. With a population of 2,399 living in a townsite.

This land is the traditional territory of the Dunne-za, Sauteaux, Tse'khene, Cree and Metis peoples which includes the McLeod Lake Indian Band, Sauteaux First Nations, West Moberly First Nations, Kelly Lake Cree First Nations, and Kelly Lake Metis Settlement Society within Treaty 8 Territory.

Join an active snowmobiling club and enjoy many trails. Snow-shoe or ski across groomed cross country ski trails, or venture through wilderness up canyons to frozen waterfalls.

THE TEAM

The resident will work closely with a multidisciplinary team and have lots of independence while at the same time having lots of support. The clinic is an APP payment model with 20-30 minute appointments for each patient, which allows for lots of time for teaching, notes, and building relationships with patients.

Tumbler Ridge is a diagnostic & treatment center. We have no inpatients. The emergency department, family medicine clinic, ambulance bay, public health and our IPT team area all under the same roof.

Rural medicine practiced in a diagnostic and treatment setting in a remote but well-equipped community. Working closely with a multidisciplinary group and allied health professionals. We have support from larger facilities such as Dawson Creek and Fort St. John.
