The Climate Education in Teacher Education (CETE) research project seeks to hire a part-time, short-term Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) to help enact a sub-research project that looks to gather knowledge from local Indigenous knowledge-holders and Elders around Climate Change Education. The contract is for 3 months to begin, and there may be an extension.

Pay is \$25.00/hr + mandatory costs (gross pay is \$29.93/hr). Hours are flexible and approximately 10 hours/week.

Applicants must have experience with managing a research project, including conducting literature reviews, supporting budgets, editing written works, and collaborating with a team of researchers. Applicants must be a current UNBC graduate student.

Work can be accomplished remotely and via Zoom meetings with the research team.

- Literature Review
