• NSERC Discovery Horizons Grants support investigator-initiated individual and team projects that broadly integrate or transcend disciplines to advance knowledge in the natural sciences and engineering.

Letter of Intent deadline (mandatory): June 14, 2024 Full application deadline (by invitation only): October 18, 2024

NSERC Discovery Grants support ongoing programs of research in the natural sciences and engineering with long-term goals rather than a single short-term project or collection of projects.

Other Grants and Scholarships

- <u>National Science Foundation Global Centres: Bioeconomy</u> aims to encourage and support international, interdisciplinary collaborative research centres that will develop use-inspired research to address global challenges through the bioeconomy. Applicants to this initiative must collaborate with at least one US-based researcher who meets the NSF eligibility requirements.

 Application deadline: June 11, 2024
- Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships are Canada's most prestigious and highest valued awards for postdoctoral researchers. Valued at \$70,000 per year for 2 years, the competition is open to both Canadian and international researchers who have recently completed a PhD, PhD-equivalent, or health professional degree.
 Internal Expression of Interest deadline (mandatory): July 8, 2024
 Full application deadline: by invitation only
- New Frontiers in Research Fund—Exploration Stream funds high-risk, high-reward and interdisciplinary research projects that bring disciplines together beyond traditional disciplinary or common interdisciplinary approaches by research teams with the capacity to explore something new that might fail, but that has the potential for significant impact.

Internal Grants

- <u>UNBC Green Grants</u> are accepted from any member of the UNBC community, including students, staff, faculty and campus based organizations, and provide one-time seed funding for research, education and civic engagement projects that promote sustainability at UNBC.
 - Application deadlines: twice per year in February and October
- <u>UNBC Green Travel Grants</u> are accepted from any member of the UNBC community, including students, staff, and faculty, and provide financial support for travel and registration fees for conferences, training sessions, etc. that add to the sustainability knowledge and skills base at UNBC, or communicate the UNBC experience to a broader audience.
 Application deadline: Continuous intake
- Research Strategic Initiatives Grants (RSIG) welcome requests from all UNBC faculty, research organizations, graduate and undergraduate student groups engaged in research. Funds are directed toward research activities for which other sources of funding are not available.

What should co-applicants on research grants do to ensure that funds can be transferred to UNBC?

- Any time researchers are part of grant applications where funding will be coming to UNBC, details must be submitted in ROMEO at least 5 days in advance of the external deadline. This includes grant applications on which UNBC researchers are coapplicants.
- ♦ Applications should be submitted to ROMEO using the "external grant or contract application form", being sure to include the following information:
 - \Diamond Project Team Info tab—include the name and affiliation of the PI who is applying for the funding in the comments box.
 - Project Sponsor tab—indicate the name of the institution of the PI as the "agency", rather than the original funder (e.g. if you are a co-applicant on a SSHRC Partnership Grant where the PI is a UBC faculty member, you should indicate the funding agency as "UBC", not "SSHRC"). Select "contract" or "transfer agreement" as the program. Indicate the agency and program of the original source of funding (e.g. SSHRC Partnership Grant for the example above) in the comments box. Include details on the funding amounts that will be coming to UNBC (not the total amount of the award) in the "disbursements" boxes.
 - Attachments tab—please attach a copy of the complete grant application, including the budget.
- Once you have been notified that the grant application is successful, please submit an amendment request in Romeo to attach a "request for research agreement" form, available here. This will allow the research contracts team to start the process of drafting the transfer agreement with the PI's institution.

Reminder: all grant and contract applications $\underline{\text{must}}$ be received by the Office of Research and Innovation via ROMEO a minimum of 5 business days in advance of the agency deadline. Please allow enough time for Chair and Dean approval prior to the internal deadline.
