

Valued at \$10,000 each, these awards are meant to supplement the Graduate Entrance Research Scholarship and BC Graduate Scholarship for PhD recipients. GERS and BCGS recipients will be prioritized but any PhD students who meet the eligibility criteria are welcome to apply.

To be eligible for an award, students must meet the below criteria:

- Be a full-time student currently enrolled in their <u>second or third year</u> of study in a PhD program, when holding the award.
- Have maintained an overall GPA of 4.00.
- Be making satisfactory progress in their degree and have up to date paper work on file with the Office of Graduate Administration.
- Cannot have previously received the GERS PhD Support Supplement or GES/GERA scholarships.
- Canadian citizens and those with permanent residence status must have also applied for a competitive provincial or national scholarship (eg. NSERC, SSHRC, CIHR, Mitacs Accelerate) if not already holding one. Generally, an award of greater than \$15,000 would qualify as a competitive award.
