Note on Field-Based or Practical Work in ORTM Courses

ORTM courses with field/outdoor or practical components. Note that the type and intensity of field experiences varies year to year, instructor to instructor, and student group to student group. We've organized classes into six categories to provide some specifics. Category 1 tells you whether fieldwork and practical skills are a core focus of academic content (not just 'doing' of fieldwork as a method of learning). Categories 2, 3, and 4 tell you what sort of field components are typical in the class. Category 5 "Practical Skills" is a bit harder to assess; here we focus on courses with a 'practice' or 'application' component happening indoors (like GIS skills, research skills, or writing program or management plans). We hope all our courses teach some practical skills (like how to write a report or a policy brief). Finally, Category 6 indicates if the course might include some certification or credential – though this isn't guaranteed as it changes significantly with content, instructor, and availability.
