Policies & Procedures

SUBJECT: PETS ON CAMPUS

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define criteria for domestic animals on campus.

2. Authority

The Director of Facilities reports to the Vice President (Administration and Finance) and is responsible for the administration of this policy.

3. Scope

This policy pertains to the entire University community.

4. Policy

No pets, under any circumstances shall be allowed to enter any of the buildings on the UNBC Prince George Campus with the exception of "Seeing Eye" dogs and "Assistive"* dogs. No pets shall be left unattended on the grounds of the UNBC Prince George Campus. Any pets brought onto the campus grounds, must be restrained by leashes or by other means and must remain with the owner at all times. The owner shall be responsible for cleaning any mess left by the animal.

If an animal is found in an office with its owner, the owner will be asked to remove the animal from the building. Security will notify the pet owner's supervisor of the policy infraction. Stray animals will be taken to either the SPCA or City Pound.

* Assistive dog aids hearing impaired persons and persons with mobility problems.
